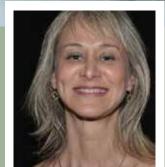


## ANNA B. BARANOWSKY, Ph.D., C. Psych., CEO

Dr. Baranowsky is a Toronto-based psychologist specializing in helping trauma survivors. She is also founder and CEO of the Traumatology Institute, and sits on the board of directors at the Green Cross Academy of Traumatology. Dr. Baranowsky has developed several esteemed programs and tools in her field, including the Clinical Traumatologist training program, the Trauma Recovery Program, Trauma Practice: Tools for Stabilization & Recovery and the *Ask Dr. Anna* online video series.



Thematic Map & Release (TM&R) is a powerful *advanced-practice intervention* for helping trauma survivors resolve core negative beliefs. It is a key component of the Trauma Practice, a tri-phasic trauma treatment model created by Dr. Baranowsky. In this one-day experiential workshop, practitioners will learn to implement TM&R while navigating three areas: safety and stabilization; working through trauma; and reconnecting to meaningful activities.
